- Provided strong support for a new single-use plastic bag ordinance that was approved.

Green Schools

- Reduced waste further by recycling all paper towels, in addition to collecting food scraps, at all campuses.
- Meatless Mondays adopted at all elementary schools.
- Researched Green Ribbon School designation and began process of nominating Lafayette School District.
- · Began working with district on how to eliminate toxic chemicals from being used around our schools.
